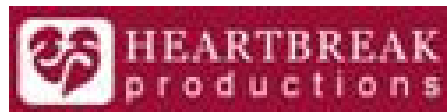


SUMMER OPEN AIR TOUR 2010 – Promoter Publicity Copy Guidelines
